Docents are required to volunteer four hours a month and attend a meeting on the third Monday of every month. The monthly meeting will provide continuing education as well as time for the scheduling of shifts. Docents may sign up for more hours, and are expected to be present for their shifts and ready to lead pre-scheduled group tours as well as guided tours that are scheduled according to demand. Docents receive unlimited access to Louisiana State Museum properties and behind-the-scenes access to new exhibits.
