#### Call to Order

Florence Jumonville called the meeting to order at 10:05 am.

#### **Collections Committee Action Items**

#### Minutes from the meeting on January 16, 2025

A motion was made by Suzanne Perlis to approve the minutes. Seconded by Mary Coulon, a vote to approve was unanimous.

#### **Proposed Acquisitions**

#### Gifts for the Permanent Collection:

20 gifts were introduced for Carnival, Costumes & Textiles, Maps & Manuscripts, Music, Science & Technology, Visual Arts collections.

A few high points are presented here. Wayne Phillips Described several Carnival items including an array of jewelry, costumes, and photographs gifted by Mrs. Michael Bright White from the Krewes of Osiris, Mithras, and Comas. Phillips also highlighted a 1950s era sign from the Club My-O-My being gifted by the Friends of the Cabildo.

David Kunian introduced recordings by Louis Prima, a washboard used by Washboard Lissa Driscoll, and photographs from the Jazz Funeral of Harold Duke Dejan.

Claudia Kheel presented a daguerreotype posthumous portrait of Rose Emilie Sigur.

#### **Gift for the Study Collection:**

A single acquisition of a digital copy photograph of Ella Levert, Queen of the Krewe of Proteus is to be added to the Carnival Collection.

A motion to approve acquisitions was made by Suzanne Perlis.

Seconded by Mary Coulon, the Committee unanimously recommended the acquisitions be sent to the full Board for approval.

#### **Proposed Deaccession of Objects from Permanent Collection**

62 items from Decorative Arts, Music, Science & Technology, and Visual Arts were presented by David Kunian and Claudia Kheel for sale at auction.

Among Kunian's objects are a group of radio transcription recordings made by the US Army. Tiffany Adler suggested offering the (17) records to the WWII museum.

A motion to approve the 62 items was made by Suzanne Perlis.

Seconded by Mary Coulon, the Committee recommended the deaccessions be sent to the Board for approval.

#### **Outgoing Loans and Outgoing Loan Renewals**

David Kunian described 5 objects related to Clifton Chenier proposed for display at the N.O. Jazz & Heritage Festival and Foundation.

Tom Strider described the proposed renewal of 4 loans to the Jackson Barracks Military Museum. Items are primarily military artifacts, including an 1860 cannon and a Hotchkiss revolving cannon limber, as well as 5 Hurricane Katrina-related objects.

A motion to recommend approval was made by Suzanne Perlis.

It was seconded by Mary Coulon.

A vote to approve was unanimous.

#### Conservation

Wayne Phillips presented two early 19<sup>th</sup>-century silk dresses for treatment by Jessica Hack Textile Restoration. The garments are scheduled for inclusion in the upcoming Lafayette exhibition.

A motion to recommend approval was made by Suzanne Perlis.

It was seconded by Mary Coulon.

A vote to approve was unanimous.

The Committee was notified of damage (puncture) to a portrait, *Governor Pierre LeMoyne, Sieur d'Iberville et d'Ardillieres*, currently on display in the Governor's Press Room at the Capitol. The painting was patched on site by Hudson Salah Conservation.

#### **Incoming Loans**

Members were notified of 8 incoming loans for three exhibitions: *Portraying the Past: Perspectives on American Indian Mounds in Louisiana* (Capitol Park), *Bienvenu à Général Lafayette* (Cabildo), and *Economy Hall: The Hidden History of a Free Black Brotherhood* (Mint).

#### **Incoming Loan Renewals**

Capitol Park has renewed 4 loans currently on long-term display. Lenders include the Louisiana Division of Archaeology, Port of Greater Baton Rouge, Office of State Parks, and New Orleans Fire Department Museum.

Erin Patterson presented a copy of an updated Collections Management Policy with relevant forms. She suggested that the Committee revisit and update the Collecting Policy that is included in the larger document. She will send a PDF copy to members.

According to Susan Maclay, when she started work at the Louisiana Museum Foundation in 2001, there were three paintings in the corner of the LMF Presbytere office. She was told they were left for LMF, probably for auction. One painting was in fact sold at auction, one was donated to WWII, and the third a portrait of an unidentified African-American male, assumed to be a free person of color, remained in LMF hands. It was moved to MJL for a time when LMF moved its offices there. It was damaged by rain from a roof leak, and subsequently rescued by Polly Roman who stored in her office at 1000 Chartres. - Jan. 2025, T. Strider

#### VIII. Old Business

Proposal to raise the dollar amount for conservation treatment that Museum Director can approve before receiving the recommendation of the Collections Committee and approval from the Board of Directors, from \$1,000 to \$3,500 per item.

Excerpt from LSM Collections Management Manual

#### B. Conservation Policy

The following policies relate to the work of conservators contracted to work on objects in the Museum's collections.

It is the responsibility of the assigned Collections Curator, in consultation with the Collections Division Director, to supervise conservation treatments.

All proposed conservation treatments must be recommended by the Collections Committee and approved by the Board of Directors before the contract can be executed, except under the following circumstance:

The Museum Assistant Secretary has the authority to enter into contracts for the conservation of collection items before receiving the recommendation of the Collections Committee and the approval of the Board of Directors when the expense is less than \$1,000 per item (but no greater than the approved Irby budget for conservation).

Contracts for conservation services, including requests by the contract conservator for the Museum to sign their treatment proposal or contract, must be processed through the Deputy Assistant Secretary prior to signing.

#### IX. New Business

#### AMENDMENT NO. 8

On page 19, delete lines 23 through 29 in their entirety and insert the following:

"(3) The Board of Directors of the Louisiana State Museum (R.S. 25:341 et seq.). The board shall continue to exercise those its powers, duties, and functions, and responsibilities with respect to accessions, deaccessions, loans, and conservation of the buildings, collections, and exhibitions the collections of the Louisiana State Museum which it is authorized by law to exercise, all in accordance with professional museum practices as the standards established by the American Association Alliance of Museums, except as otherwise provided by law; and the members of the board shall continue to serve as trustees for the William Irby Trust."


