Many groups of people contributed to the victories of Spanish Louisiana against the British. *Find each of the mannequins shown in this guide to learn more.*

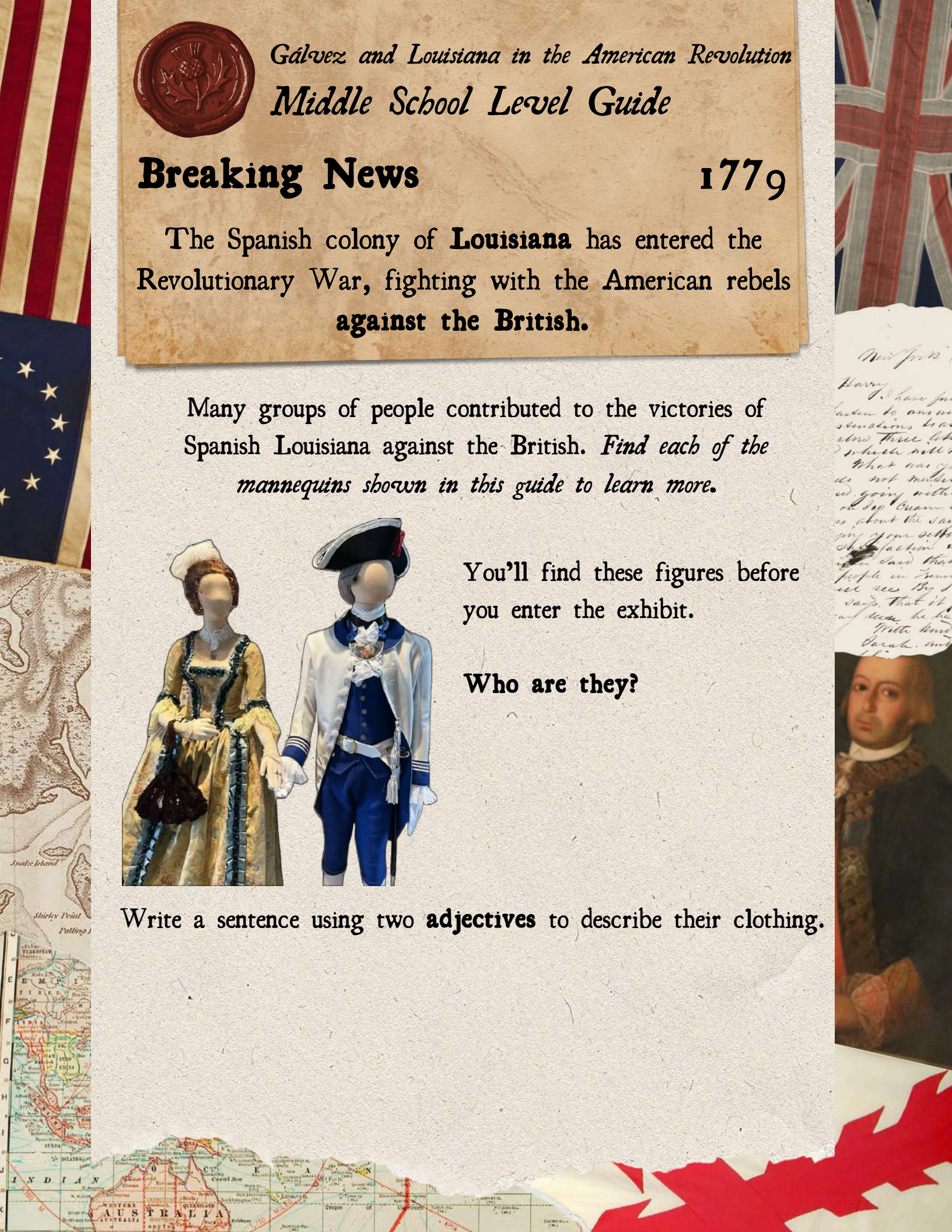
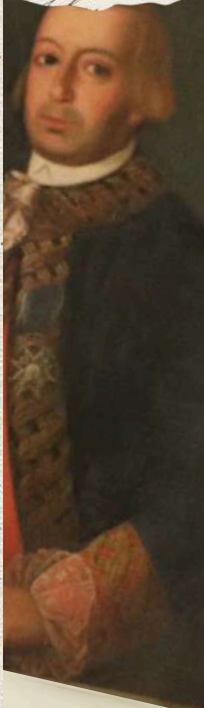

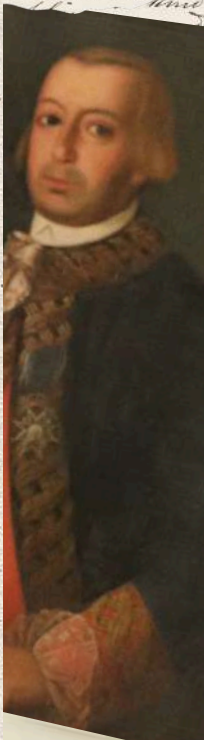

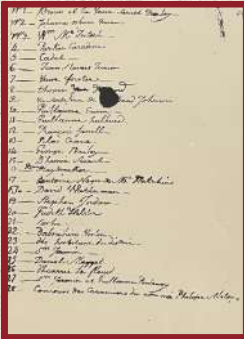

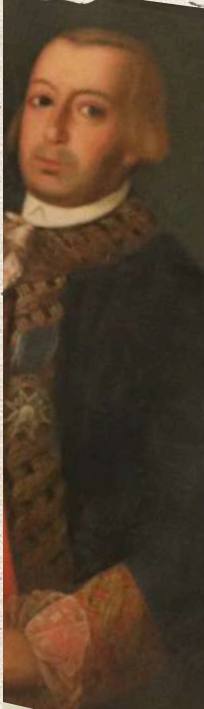
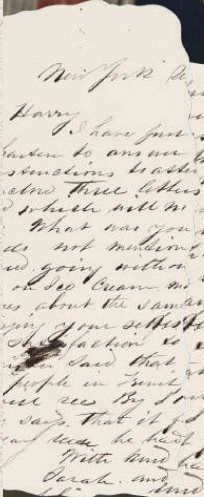
